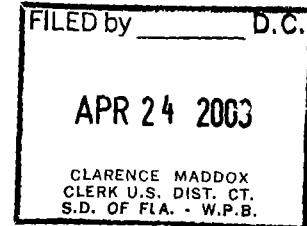




**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S EMERGENCY
